
STUDENTS – POST-SECONDARY ENROLLMENT PROGRAM

Post secondary enrollment opportunities include dual credit courses, concurrent enrollment courses, and early college programs. See the building's course book for current offerings. A student may enroll in courses offered by an accredited public or private college or university located in Indiana that grants a baccalaureate or associate degree on a full-time or part-time basis during grade 11, grade 12, or both. The student may not be eligible to participate if participation would delay the student's progress towards high school graduation, if the request is for enrollment in a postsecondary course that is offered by WWS and participation would result in cancellation of the course due to low enrollment, or based upon additional criteria set by the Superintendent and/or his or her designee from time to time.

The courses approved for secondary credit must have identical quality and rigor as the course taught on the postsecondary campus, must have identical syllabi to the course taught on the postsecondary campus, and identical student learning outcomes expected as the course taught on the postsecondary campus.

A student may be entitled to credit toward graduation requirements for each course the student successfully completes at the institution in accordance with the contract for dual credit with the eligible institution the student is attending. The student's school records must indicate that the credits were earned at an eligible institution.
