
GENERAL COMMITMENTS – ACCIDENTS AND WORKER’S COMPENSATION

Westfield Washington Schools (WWS) is committed to a safe working and learning environment.

In case of any accident or injury in any building owned or leased by WWS; on WWS property or grounds (including parking lots, athletic facilities, etc.); in vehicles owned, leased, or operated by WWS; and during WWS events, even if held outside of WWS property (for example, prom or field trips), school employees in the vicinity of the accident shall ensure first aid is rendered, within the limits of their knowledge of recommended practices, e.g. universal precautions, and that every action shall be taken to protect life, health, and safety. School employees shall also summon medical assistance, notify administrative personnel, and parents as necessary.

School employees shall immediately complete the applicable accident report form, Student Accident Report Form or General Accident Report Form, following an accident, or as soon as practical thereafter, but no later than twenty-four (24) hours after the accident.

WWS complies with all state worker’s compensation laws that govern work-related injuries and illnesses.
