SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2022-2023

PRE-K

- 1 backpack that fastens and can easily hold a folder
- 1 composition notebook
- 1 pocket folder
- 1 pack of 6-8 of glue sticks
- 1 complete change of clothes in a bag labeled with your child's first and last name
- 1 small blanket or beach towel to be used for rest time, labeled with your child's first and last name *(Please ensure this can easily fit inside your child's backpack.)*
- 1 pack of crayons (16 or 24 pack)



KINDERGARTEN

- 1 book bag (regular size) that fastens and can hold a folder
 - 2 primary writing journals
 - 1 pair of Fiskars scissors (blunt tip)
 - 24 small glue sticks
 - 4 boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)
 - 1 pack washable markers
 - 1 box of colored pencils
 - 1 pack of sharpened pencils
 - 1 large zippered pencil pouch (one enclosure)
 - 1 pack of multi-color construction paper
 - 1 change of clothes in a labeled bag
 - 1 beach towel, labeled with name, for rest

1ST GRADE

- 1 book bag that fastens and can hold a folder
- 3 composition notebooks (wide ruled)
- 1 heavy duty, 2-pocket poly folder
- 2 packs of glue sticks
- 2 pairs of scissors (blunt tip)
- 1 pack of Crayola markers (fat tip)
- 4 boxes of crayons (16 count)
- 1 school supply box
- 1 change of clothes in a labeled bag
- 3 boxes of sharpened pencils



2ND GRADE

- 3 pocket folders with no prongs (one red, one blue, one black)
 - 3 composition notebooks (wide ruled)
 - 1 pair of scissors
 - 1 pencil pouch or school box
 - 24 glue sticks
 - 2 large erasers
 - 24 cap erasers
 - 24 pencils
 - 4 boxes of crayons (24 count)
 - 1 pack of highlighters

3RD GRADE

- 6 Two-pocket folders (no clasps) –
- 1 each – Red, Blue, Green, Yellow, Purple, Orange
- 1 Two-pocket folder (no clasps) for Specials
- 2 Composition Books
- 2 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 zippered pencil pouch or a supply box
- 1 pair of scissors
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pack of erasers
- 1 black Sharpie marker
- 1 pack of pencils
- 1 pack of washable markers (8-count)
- 1 pack of colored pencils (12-count)
- 1 box of crayons (24-count)
- Sketch Pad for Art Class



4TH GRADE

- 4 composition notebooks
 - 1 three ring binder (1 ½ or 2 inches)
 - 1 pack of wide-ruled notebook paper
 - 1 pack of 5 subject dividers
 - 1 pocket folder (heavy duty, plastic with holes and clasps – labeled as Safe Place Folder)
 - 2 two-pocket folders *without* clasps
 - 1 zippered pencil pouch with holes for binder
 - 1 box of crayons
 - 1 pair of scissors
 - 2 glue sticks
 - 2 highlighters

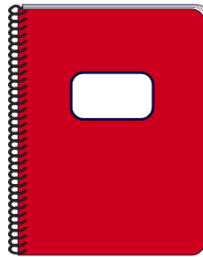

- 1 zippered pencil pouch that clips into binder
- 2 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 2 packs of colored pencils
- 1 pack of crayons (24 count)
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 liquid glue bottle
- 1 small pack of cap erasers
- Sketch Pad for Art Class
