Dear Parent/Carer,

3. It is important to have a password or code within the device settings to reduce the risk of accessing unsuitable information.
4. If we are not sure about something on the internet, we are to ask a trusted adult – 'to share for care' (with specific reference to looking at what older siblings/cousins maybe accessing on the internet).
5. We are not to speak to people we do not know on the internet (with specific reference to online gaming).

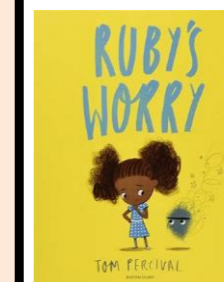
