Attached is the proposed 2020-2021 Operating Budget in the amount of \$301,539,924 or a 6.52% increase over the 2019-2020 budget.

Please note that due to extreme increases in enrollment, SPED, HealthCare, Transportation, and Facilities costs, the BOE proposed budget request is greater than in the recent past, looming at approximately 6.52%. However, we are committed to presenting a budget that truly represents what we believe to be the cost of operating our district, in order to provide an education that cultivates the productive habits of mind, body, and heart in every Stamford Public Schools student.
