HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR THE COURSE?

Course Requirements and Expectations:

Classroom Time:

- * Patient Care
- * Vitals, Screenings, Procedures, Etiquette
- * Theory and Clinical
- * Skills check-off

Hands-on learning: students are expected to be interactive throughout the course.

Clinical Hours: Students are required to complete 100 Clinical hours in a Skilled Nursing Facility, making students eligible to take the American Red Cross CNA Exam after completion of the course.

Course includes: Theory and Clinical training, textbook, skills workbook, Uniform, fingerprinting fee, and CPR/First Aid Card.
