

Timeline for First Time Dual Enrollment Students at

East Georgia State College Summer and Fall 2022

Steps to complete before DE:

February 15	Students are provided information related to the dual enrollment process.	<input type="checkbox"/>
February 15-28	Students interested in dual enrollment must email with Ms. Pace or Ms. Anderson to determine if they meet the 3.0 HOPE GPA requirement.	<input type="checkbox"/>
March 1-4	Students interested in dual enrollment must meet with Ms. Pace or Ms. Anderson to determine if they meet the 3.0 HOPE GPA requirement.	<input type="checkbox"/>
March 1	New dual enrollment students and parents will meet at an assigned time with Ms. Pace and Ms. Anderson to complete DE schedule. Ms. Pace and Ms. Anderson will provide students with an invitation including the date and time. Students must be accepted to East Georgia State College in order to have this meeting. Students can visit www.ega.edu to check their application status.	<input type="checkbox"/>
March 21	Mandatory virtual dual enrollment parent meeting provided by counselors for new dual enrollment students.	<input type="checkbox"/>
March 25 and 28	Accuplacer testing sessions at SHS. Students will complete the institution application, complete the funding application, and students will be informed about other pertinent information required for acceptance. Students who do not make the minimum score will be given instructions to retest. It is the student's responsibility to schedule their testing sessions.	<input type="checkbox"/>
If applicable, remediation process should begin immediately	Students who do not pass a portion of the Accuplacer will have to attend remediation at East Ga State College and pay to retest on the section that is needed by April 8th. Remediation has to be scheduled with Jeffery Waller, (478) 289-2151 or email jdwaller@ega.edu . Students will be <u>allowed only two opportunities to retest</u> . If a student is not successful in these attempts, they will not be able to participate in Dual Enrollment until a later semester.	<input type="checkbox"/>
April 4	Dual enrollment registration for new students with Ms. Madison Wimberly begins. Refer to the webpage. Students must make their own appointment with her through the DE webpage.	<input type="checkbox"/>
April 8	Deadline for Accuplacer retest if needed.	<input type="checkbox"/>
April 15	Priority deadline for Summer and Fall 2022 dual enrollment registration.	<input type="checkbox"/>
April 29	This is the final deadline for submission of all paperwork and scheduling appointments with EGSC for dual enrollment schedules. <u>Students will not be accepted into the DE program after this date for Summer and Fall 2022 semester.</u> Students wishing to participate after this deadline will work toward Spring 2023 semester. Students should be ready for registration with Ms. Madison Wimberly by April 29th. Students can visit www.ega.edu to check their application status. If they have been accepted, they can make an appointment with Ms. Madison Wimberly.	<input type="checkbox"/>

ALL of the steps listed above must be completed no later than **April 29, 2022** in order to participate in the DE program for Summer and Fall 2022. Failure to complete **ALL** of these steps by **April 29, 2022** will result in students not participating in the DE program for Summer and Fall 2023.
