Introductions: All officers (Monica Shouse President; Karen Kelly Vice President; Secretary Alice Siebecker; Treasurer Elizabeth Linski;) were introduced along with all attendees.

Principal's Report: Ken Gibson – Intermin Principal during search for new Principal

Diane Corneer outlined the counseling staff and how they were assigned alphabetically to students; the Navience program, an online program to help students with college applications and submissions; the MSU College Fair to be held at the Shroyer Gym; PSAT test to be given to Juniors. She also covered that administrative appeals – Mike Ruhl (Freshman and Senior; Sara Haze (Sophomore and Junior).

Ken Gibson said that there were 1,910 students so far this year, with some of the classes being big and over 30 students per class. There are some rooms that aren't being used as there is no teaching staff available, as funding follows students a year later.
