

BHS PAC Meeting – April 11, 2013

Meeting brought to order at 12:15 by President Monica Shouse

Introductions of all members and guests

Principal Ken Gibson gave an overview of Title I information; Title I addresses educational needs within the school; AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) for math was 79%, target was 80%

Steve Johnson, Assistant Superintendent of Bozeman School District also gave overview of Title I program in schools – BHS qualifies for Title I due to 1 school in 1 district; 4 elementary schools qualify while 3 do not; 1 middle school qualifies while the other one does not. See Bozeman School District website for more details. May 7 is school election – 3 incumbents will run for school board, they are uncontested. High school district will have a general fund levy request. Dan Swanson commented on levy request, it's basically for continued operation of the high school with largest expenditures being teachers and staff.

Ken Gibson announced Senior Breakfast will be by football field 8-10 a.m. June 6th – need parent help; June 6th will be graduation practice at the field house with Graduation on June 9th at 2 p.m.

Worthy Student scholarships will be presented on May 29th at 7 PM

Treasurer's report: Elizabeth Linsky – After Prom account is at \$5,840.00 and running short; tickets for After Prom will be on sale at lunch starting following Monday for \$10.00 presale. It will be \$15.00 at the door. Senior Sober account is at \$1,346.00 and letters will be going out to community for more fund donations etc. General account is at \$8,876.00; Worthy Student Scholarship donation will be \$1,000 and Lincolns for Levies donation will be at \$500.

Volunteer opportunities: Teacher Appreciation luncheon is May 2 – check your emails for food needed etc.; After Prom still needs volunteers;

Monica Shouse said that the donation from PAC to the Mandeville Creek restoration project is on hold as the project has slowed down. Monica presented the possibility of PAC donating monies to After Prom (\$1,000) and Senior Sober (\$500). Motion was made and passed to donate monies to After Prom (\$1,000) and Senior Sober (\$500).

Monica Shouse discussed the Verizon App challenge which Rachel Shouse outlined in a letter to PAC. Rachel would like PAC to be aware of the App Challenge at that there is an organization at the high school looking for money to help get the wheels rolling.
