

Meeting Minutes

SBDM Council – Regular Meeting

Date: April 14, 2021 Time: 3:45 p.m.

I. Opening Business

- a. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 3:45 p.m. Members present were Christopher King, Rodney Covington, Corina Byford, John Williams, John Larkin, Ashley Fritsche and Katy Walls.
- b. **Approval of Agenda:** Mr. Larkin made a motion to approve the agenda. Mrs. Walls seconded the motion and the agenda was approved.
- c. **Approval of Minutes:** Mrs. Fritsche made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Mrs. Byford seconded and the minutes were approved.

II. Budget Report

- Mrs. Lee presented the March 2021 budget report. After discussion, Mrs. Fritsche made a motion to approve the budget report as presented. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and the budget report was approved.

III. SBDM Projected Budget 2021-2022

- Mr. King presented the council with his projected budget for 2021-2022. As of March, our projected SBDM allocation is \$104,655 for the 2021-2022 school year. Mr. King made the projected budget based off of last years budget. Mrs. Byford made a motion to approve the 2021-2022 projected budget. Mr. Covington seconded the motion and the projected 2021-2022 budget was approved.

IV. Open Forum

- a. Lisa Hays reported the Harbour Youth Service Center has 28 students and 21 faculty members enrolled in a Healthy Lifestyle Step Challenge for April.
- b. Lisa Hays reported that Soup for the Soul is always looking for volunteers for the Summer Feeding program. In addition, anyone who wants to help keep the blessing box stocked outside of CCHS is welcome to assist.
- c. Mr. King told the council about Summer School. We will have two 10-day sessions that run from 7:30-11:30. It is targeted for Juniors and Seniors for the first session and will be opened up for others as spots come available. Students who earn a 40% or higher are eligible to attend.
- d. Mr. King reported on the accelerated camp that CCHS will host the 1st week of August. It is five days and will run from 7:30-11:30 and is designed for kids who are in Honors, Accelerated or AP classes.
- e. Mr. King informed the council that there will be a student orientation before the 2021-2022 school year. It will be open to any student.

V. 2021-2022 CCR Discussion

- Mr. King discussed the CCR options for CCHS for the 2021-2022 school year. He proposed rotating through different sections such as Financial Literacy, Soft Skills, and ACT prep. We would no longer be in Homeroom groups. Students would earn a ¼ credit for CCR each year so a total of 1 credit for four years. Mr. Larkin asked if we had enough devices to accommodate all of the needs and Mr. King said it would have to worked out via scheduling but would be doable. Mr. Williams said that our kids need the help, especially coming off two nontraditional years due to Covid-19 and we need to do what is in their best interest. The council discussed the length of time needed for

CCR to accommodate for RTI. KSI says we need 60-90 minutes a week to meet the need for RTI. After discussion, the council came to a consensus that 30 minutes twice a week or 60 minutes per week would be enough for the upcoming school year.

- Mr. Larkin made a motion to approve 30 minutes twice a week of CCR time to meet RTI requirements. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and the motion passed.

VI. 2021-2022 Master Bell Schedule

- Ashley Fritsche made a motion to approve the Bell Schedule with 30 minutes of CCR time on Tuesday and Thursday at the same time each week. Mrs. Walls seconded the motion and the motion passed. The new bell schedule will be sent to the faculty.

VII. 2021-2022 AEC/DTC Master Bell Schedule

- Mr. King presented the council with the 2021-2022 AEC/DTC Master Bell Schedule. Mr. Larkin made a motion to approve the schedule as presented. Mrs. Walls seconded the motion and the motion passed.

VIII. CCHS 2021-2022 Course Fees

- Mr. King presented the council with the CCHS 2021-2022 Course Fees. One major change for this year is that course fees will be able to be taken by credit card this year.
- Mrs. Byford made a motion to approve the CCHS 2021-2022 Course Fees as presented. Mr. Larkin seconded the motion and the motion passed.
