

AP World History Summer Assignment 2022

Purpose:

- "...to ease us into the stream of world history after 1200 by looking briefly at several major turning points in the human story that preceded it. These include the breakthrough to agriculture, the rise of those distinctive societies called civilizations, the making of the major cultural or religious traditions that accompanied those civilizations, and the broad patterns of interaction among the peoples of the ancient world" (Strayer, p. 9).
- To develop and practice reading, note-taking, and study skills that will be essential to your mastery of course content.

Assignment:

1. Before June 15, join *AP World History – Summer* in Schoology using the access code provided by your teacher.
2. Between June 15 and August 1, relax and enjoy your Summer. Work on something of personal interest. Do some extra credit if you like.
3. After August 1:
 - Review the links in the Resources folder on reading and taking notes from a textbook.
 - Carefully read and take notes on Chapter 1 of our text, *Ways of the World* (a digital copy can be found in the Resources folder). Your notes must be your own original and handwritten work and use one of the formats described in the Resources folder (formal outline, informal outline, or basic notes). Your notes will be submitted for grading on the first day of class.
 - Using your notes, study Chapter 1 content in preparation for a quiz to be administered during the first week of class.

Recovery: I would not provide this Summer assignment if I did not believe it were important to "hit the ground running" on the first day of school. However, **if for some reason you are unable to complete this work prior to the start of classes, do not despair, and more importantly, DO NOT DROP THE CLASS!** There will be ample opportunity during the first quarter to recover from a low grade on the Summer assignment.
