Student Expectations:

- Teachers and staff will be reporting to Northwest High School for their normal work hours, unless otherwise notified. Any changes in teacher availability will be communicated, including if a teacher is ill or unavailable to host a live class.
- Students will be expected to attend each of their classes according to the schedule.
- Students will not be expected to log in for Study Halls.
- Students will not be expected to log in for Advisory Period.
- Attendance will be taken in each period via Google Meet. Parents should contact the Attendance Office if a student is absent or ill for the day.
- Instruction will occur in each class period. Students should work through each of their teachers' Google Classrooms for the necessary links and instructions.
- Students will be expected to have their cameras on for attendance and participation purposes.
- Microphones should be muted when first joining the class to reduce the initial "feedback" while all students log-in.
- Grading practices and procedures will continue as if in the traditional setting.
- Students should be dressed appropriately for class.
- Students should be sure to work from a location that is quiet, free from distraction, and has the necessary lighting for their faces to be seen on camera.
- Conference hours are not mandatory unless requested by the teacher. Students may use these times to get clarification on assignments, seek additional help or to interact with the teacher about any other items of concern.
- Parents may monitor student progress and attendance through the HAC account.
- Students are encouraged to contact the teacher through their Gmail.
- Contact your counselors if there is a need; they are still available for you.
