TRANSPORTATION (DRIVING) POLICY

1. These regulations have been established in cooperation with all local school districts.
2. Students who violate the VLA Transportation Policy are in violation of the Code of Conduct and subject to disciplinary action. Passengers will be subject to the same disciplinary action as drivers **(This policy applies to the entire RESA site of which VLA is a part).**

PERMIT PARKING

1. All vehicles must be registered in VLA and a permit issued. The permit must be displayed as instructed.
2. Students must follow the directives of the Security Officer and employees of VLA.
3. VLA students with school year permits or temporary permits are not allowed to transport other students without permission.
4. Permits are not transferable.
5. Student permit parking is restricted to the parking lot directly west of the VLA building. Student parking in any other area on the RESA site is prohibited. Vehicles must not be left overnight.
6. Those students who receive long-term or temporary parking permits must operate their vehicles in a responsible manner in accordance with local and state traffic laws. When operating a vehicle on the RESA/VLA site, all drivers must obey the posted traffic and parking signs. The speed limit is 10 MPH. Busses always have the right of way.
7. Once a vehicle enters the RESA/VLA site, the Code of Conduct applies to its contents and the actions of all occupants.
8. All student drivers and passengers are subject to regular parking permit spot checks by staff or RESA security staff. Drivers must stop their vehicles when directed to do so and show personal identification and proof of a valid parking permit. This also applies to all passengers.
9. When students arrive they are to come into the building. Loitering in the parking lot is not permitted. Students are not permitted to visit their car while attending school and between classes.
10. Failure to follow parking and passenger permit regulations is a violation of the Code of Conduct. Violators may be denied entry to the RESA/VLA site and face disciplinary action.
11. Student drivers understand that all student drivers and their vehicle parked on school property are subject to be searched if there is reasonable suspicion that anything illegal or inappropriate may be in their possession or in their vehicle.
