Moon Area School educates more than 3,700 students from Moon and Crescent townships. The district covers an approximate 26-mile attendance area and is located 15 miles from the city of Pittsburgh and minutes from the Pittsburgh International Airport. The ethnic/racial composition of the high school is: 83% White/Caucasian, 5% Black/African-American, 4% Asian Pacific Islander, 4% Hispanic, 4% Multi-Racial. 18% of the high school student body qualifies for the free and reduced lunch program.
