

The State of Indiana has released immunization requirements for the 2022-2023 school year. In addition to all previously required vaccinations, all students will now be required to have two Hepatitis A vaccines given six months apart.

To help ensure students' vaccinations are up to date before the school year begins, Hendricks Regional Health will host an immunization clinic at Avon High School July 13 and July 20 during Oriole Preview days.

Students are welcome to attend either option. Students must have parent/guardian present or have prior written consent via registration form.

Vaccinations that will be offered include:

- Hepatitis A
- Meningococcal Conjugate (MCV4 Meningitis)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)
- Meningitis B Vaccine
- Human Papillomavirus Vaccine (HPV)

Hendricks Regional Health will provide these vaccinations and bill the student's health insurance. Please bring your photo ID and a current insurance card for Hendricks Regional Health to use for billing. If the student does not have a parent present, they may bring a signed consent form and a photocopy of parent's drivers license and insurance card.

Self-Pay will not be available. Students who do not have insurance or need a low-cost alternative are encouraged to call the Hendricks County Health Department at 317-745-9222 for an appointment.

If you have questions about your child's immunizations, the nurses will be able to answer your questions during the immunization clinics.
