WORKSHOPS AND UPDATES

Another session of College-Ready Writers will begin on December 8th focusing on good student writing and how high school students can be better prepared for college.

Brenda will provide a link to the survey for principals to provide feedback about time in their school sites called Unlocking Time project.

The Speak Up survey window is open now through the end of January. It is free and takes about 20 minutes to complete. Julie Evans will share the data at the NCPDF Steering meeting on April 26, 2019. The survey is open until January 31, 2019.
