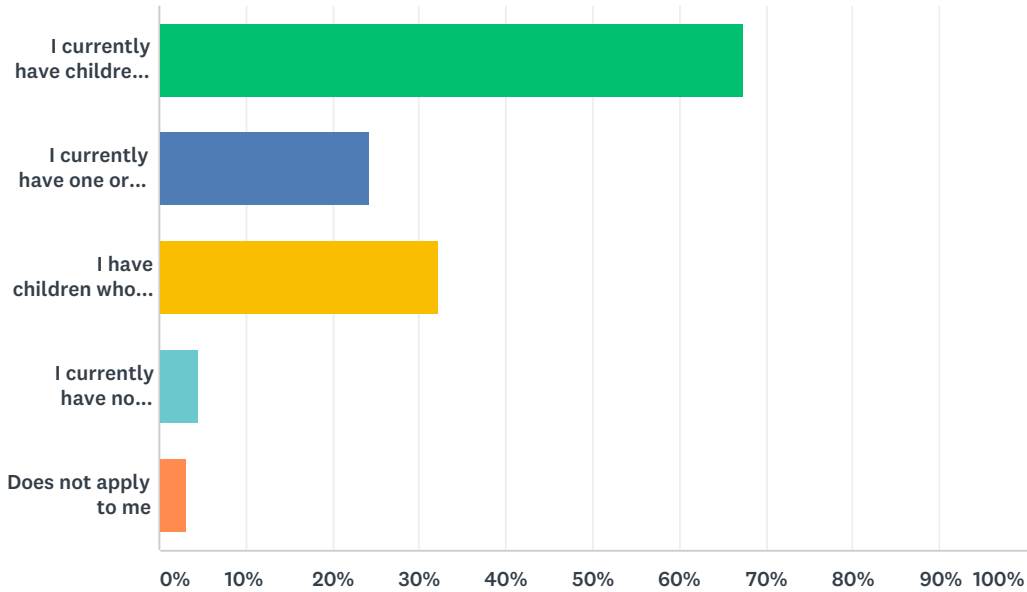

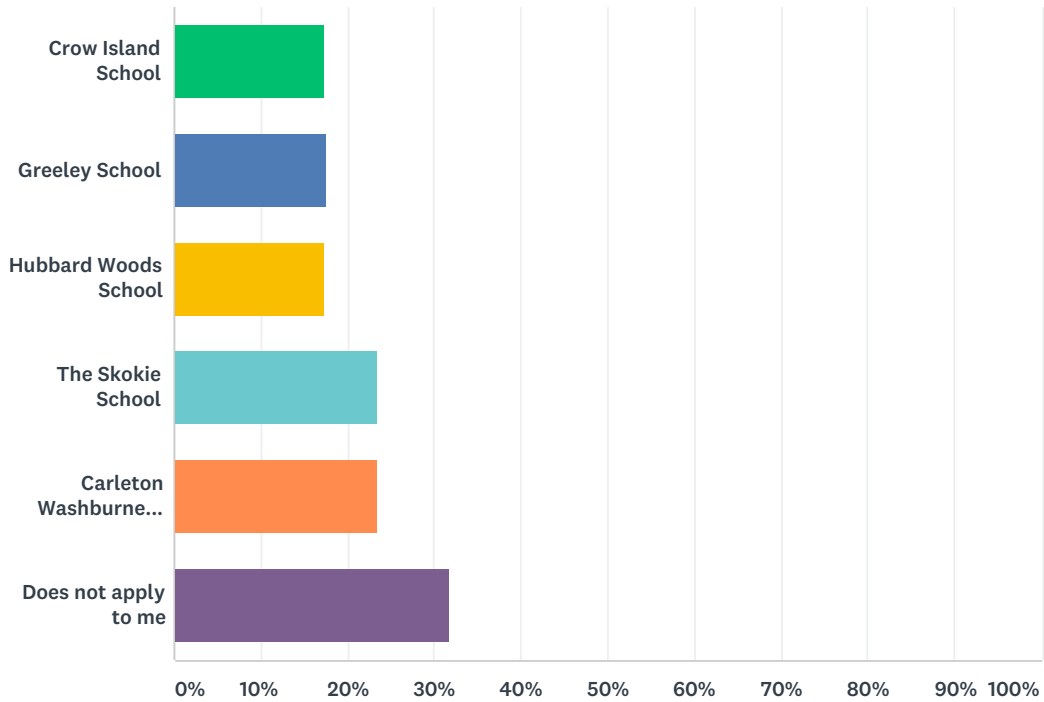

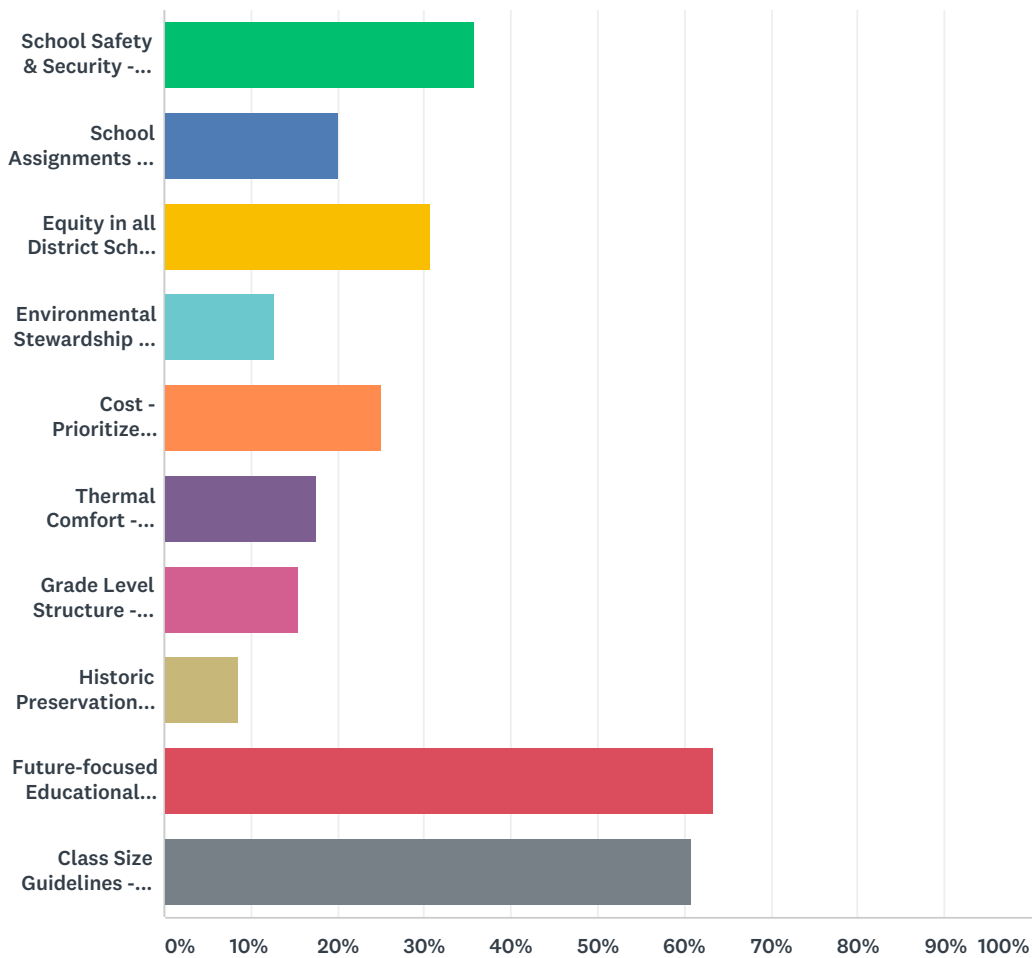

School Safety & Security - Support modern safety and security measures and current best practices in concert with local law enforcement in the design, construction, maintenance and operation of all District facilities.	35.84% 248
School Assignments - When possible, avoid moving students from their current school assignments.	20.09% 139
Equity in all District School Spaces - Ensure facilities allow for equitable delivery of academic and specialized programming at all District schools. This includes equitable spaces for makerspaces, small group learning, gym space, the arts, etc.	30.78% 213
