National School Lunch Program (NSLP) Status	Required Documentation
For students participating in the NSLP	A copy of a letter indicating current participation in the NSLP or Home Start, with your child's name and the school name.
For students enrolled in public, charter, private, virtual, denonminational or parochial schools who are not participating in the NSLP	Proof of participation in SNAP, TANF or FDPIR programs, * AND One of the following: -Copy of recent report card or progress report, with school and student's name. -Copy of student ID, with school and student's name -Letter from the school, on school letterhead, confirming the child's enrollment at the school
For homeschooled students who are not participating in the NSLP	Proof of participation in SNAP, TANF or FDPIR programs, * AND Copy of the following: Copy of document or waiver from the state or district identifying the child as homeschooled -Copy of proof of participation in a homeschool club, association or organization
