The Board of Education was presented with a first reading on the Hulse Detention Center Intergovernmental Renewal Agreement. The Hulse Juvenile Justice Center is located within the Adlai E. Stevenson District 125 boundaries. The children who reside at Depke are residents of our District, as long as they are incarcerated in the Detention Center. This agreement has been in place for the last 15 years. The Board will take final action at its next regular meeting.
