Why is the Wausau School District 1:1?

The Wausau School District's mission is to advance student learning, achievement and success. To accomplish this mission we must provide teachers the tools required to meet the needs of students in a classroom who don't naturally all learn in the same manner at the same rate and in the same way. 1:1 instructional environments allow teachers to differentiate their teaching to meet the different needs of all students. In 1:1 instructional environments, assignments can be individualized through the use of adaptive technology that gets harder or easier based on student answers. This approach also provides students with immediate feedback as learning occurs. Just as teachers are able to match instruction to students, students have a greater ability to differentiate how they demonstrate learning.

Chromebooks and iPads are powerful and engaging technology devices. When each student has a device just for his or her own use, the learning can be personalized to meet individual interests and learning styles. Chromebooks and iPads include a camera, wireless internet, a word processor, and access to all sorts of easy-to-use software applications (known as "apps" or "extensions"). These devices also come with built-in features that make learning easy and enjoyable for everyone.

Additionally, to live our mission we must prepare our students for the future that is filled with jobs that do not yet exist utilizing technologies that have not yet been created. All students will need to have the skills to work with technology in a creative and collaborative manner. This means learning must effectively integrate technology so students develop the social and jobs skills to be successful in their lives no matter the career they pursue.

Why provide Chromebook/iPad Insurance?

Wausau School District students will develop a great sense of ownership for their device over the course of the next four years as it is an integral part of every instructional experience. Purchasing insurance increases the care a student exercises with their device as it sends a strong message of responsibility, digital citizenship and ownership. Insurance will also reduce the cost of any repairs that might be required during your child's use of the Chromebook/iPad.

Device Insurance - Cost of Enrollment

- Enrollment Fee Paid (\$10.00/iPad, \$20.00/Chromebook)
- With the <u>exception of intentional/purposeful damage</u> all repairs will be covered under the insurance plan which varies based upon device issued to the student

- Lost and Missing items are NOT covered by insurance
- Family Cap Only pay for three children to insure all children enrolled as students. (Pay for the three most affordable children-chart below
- Insurance plan begins new with each year's enrollment
- Coverage Includes: Device, Charging Equipment, Logitech Crayon, and Case with Keyboard

- Coverage DOES NOT include lost or missing devices/items.
- Stolen devices/items will be covered with the filing of a theft report with the Wausau Police Department.

Decline Insurance - No Enrollment Cost

- Family assumes the full cost of any and all repairs caused by misuse, abuse or accident. (See List of Repair Costs)
- Student may be issued a "loaner" device until repair is made and payment is received. It is possible that a student will lose access to a device until repair/replacement is paid for or a payment plan has been arranged with the office.

Insurance Costs Family Cap

Families are encouraged to purchase insurance for all of their children. In an effort to make insurance as affordable as possible, the Wausau School District has developed a **Family Cap**. The **Family Cap** limits the number of children a family will need to pay for to three. Once a family purchases insurance for three children all other children in the family are automatically enrolled into the insurance program. While the **Family Cap** requires payment for three children, it should be the three children that result in the lowest total enrollment fee for the family. The chart below breaks down the potential **Family Cap** enrollment fees.
