Dear Wausau School District Families:

We hope you are enjoying your summer! Even though the school year just ended, an important deadline for next school year is quickly approaching. Any K-12 families with students in need of yellow school bus transportation for next school year must submit an application to First Student no later than July 7.

Here is a **link** to the yellow school bus application.

Here are a couple of things to note:

1. First Student generally provides home-to-school transportation for these situations:
 - a. Student resides more than two miles from their home school
 - b. Student resides in an area identified in the District's Hazardous Transportation Plan
 - c. Students with transportation identified in their Individualized Educational Program (IEP)
2. Bus stop locations are determined by the home address the Wausau School District has on file for your student(s). You'll want to make sure the address you provide on the yellow bus application is the same as the one the district has on file. If you need to change the home address on file for your student(s), please call the Longfellow Administration Center at 715-261-0500.
