

Supply List for Middle School Students (5-8)

- **Binder** (one for all subjects at school and one for each subject at home)
- **Divider** (one for each subject and two extra)
- **Quad paper (5mm)**
- **Ruled paper**
- **3x3 post-its, 3x5 index cards**
- **Complete pencil case** (ink pen, pencil, colored pencils, markers, eraser, sharpener, scissors, glue stick, ruler, triangle ruler)

Important to know!

1. The student has all materials for the current teaching units in **one binder**.
2. The student has a **divider** between each subject.
3. After each **teaching unit** (*not after each lesson*), the **student is responsible** for sorting out her/his materials in a subject binder which she/he either keeps at home.
4. With prior announcement by the teacher, the student must be able to submit **all materials** for the current school year ordered in a binder or folder.
