

The Magnolia Independent School District (MISD) will receive money for the 2022-2023 school year from the federal government through Title I, Title II, and Title III, and Title IV entitlements. Private/Nonprofit schools in the MISD attendance zone could be eligible to receive certain benefits from the following grants depending on your school's nonprofit status:

- Title I, Part A: Improving Basic Programs Operated by Local Education Agencies (*for nonprofit schools with students who meet the poverty criterion and live within the boundaries of a Magnolia ISD school served with Title I funds*)
- Title II, Part A: Teacher & Principal Training and Recruitment (*for nonprofit schools, located within MISD boundaries*)
- Title III: Ensuring High Academic Standards for Limited English Proficient and Immigrant Students (*for nonprofit schools, located within MISD boundaries*)
- Title IV: Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities (*for nonprofit schools, located within MISD boundaries*)

Participation by any private/non private school in any of the above programs will require the following:

1. Notification to MISD of your interest in possible participation by completing and returning the enclosed *Notification of Interest in Participating in the 2022-2023 Federal Program Activities* form.
2. Proof of nonprofit status for Title I, Title II, Title III and Title IV.
3. Consultation with MISD staff at federal programs planning meeting(s).
4. Agreement to allow monitoring of program(s) by MISD and Texas Education Agency staff.
5. Agreement to comply with all of the federal guidelines and requirements regarding these programs and to submit all forms in a timely manner.
