- SELF Peer Program Review
 - Purpose: The purpose of the SELF Peer Program Review is to support schools in improving special education student and teacher support by performing a review of the school's academic and behavioral programming with a team of outside observers through general and special education classroom observations and interviews, student conversations, parent surveys, and SWOT analysis.
 - Date: Thursday, May 19th, 2022.

Facilities

- Lower Campus
 - Preparation for summer facilities planning, which will include stripping and waxing of floors, painting, exterior pressure washing, and general deep cleaning of all interior spaces.
- Johnson Campus
 - Received a comprehensive Building Assessment from NOLA-PS, and will work closely with NOLA=PS on the implementation of major projects scheduled over the next three years based on a third party priority/impact evaluation.
 - Completed a long awaited walkthrough with NOLA-PS to inspect any remaining Hurricane Ida repairs based on their property insurance reports. The only remaining repairs are floor tiles in the entrance way and Resto!, repairing or replacing the high exterior fence along Eagle St. and Cohn St., and stripping and waxing classroom floors. Facilities and custodial staff already completed most of the repairs not addressed by the restoration contractor directly following Ida, for which we will receive a reimbursement from NOLA=PS
- McNair Campus

- Received a comprehensive Building Assessment from NOLA-PS, and will work closely with NOLA=PS on the implementation of major projects scheduled over the next three years based on a third party priority/impact evaluation.
- Completed a long awaited walkthrough with NOLA-PS to inspect any remaining Hurricane Ida repairs that remain based on their property insurance reports. The only remaining repairs are roof repairs on the main building (building 1) and the 2 annex classrooms (building 3), replacing damaged and removed ceiling tiles in building 3, and repairing a small section of fence near the corner of Green St. and Short St. Facilities and custodial staff already completed most of the repairs not addressed by the restoration contractor directly following Ida, for which we will receive a reimbursement from NOLA=PS

 - Lycee’s Transportation Committee completed evaluations of the vendors who bid on our RFP for student transportation services for the 2022/23 SY, and is submitting a recommendation to the board.
 - Summer School and Extended School Year transportation routes are being planned and will be provided by JJ Julien Transportation.
 - JJ Julien will also be providing transportation for 9th Grade Brevet students that require bus transportation.
