JFC Graduation Exercises

Students who plan to graduate are required a minimum of 26 units of

JFC

credit in grades nine, ten, eleven and twelve. Specific information regarding

classes and electives is available through the Guidance and Counseling Office.

Parents and students are encouraged to become aware of the requirements for

graduation that pertain to them and form a plan for reaching academic goals.

Students must be enrolled in enough credits to complete graduation

requirements to be eligible for participation in graduation exercises. Students

who have not completed all requirements prior to graduation may be allowed to

participate in graduation subject to the following:

a) For students who have not completed the requirements prior to graduation,

there must be a reasonable belief that the coursework will be successfully

completed prior to the beginning of the next school term.

b) Coursework that is intended to be transferred to Pittsburg High School for

credit must be approved in advance by the Guidance and Counseling Office.

c) Students participating in graduation who have not completed requirements

will not receive a diploma. Diplomas will be issued only after all

coursework is completed.

Eligibility for participation in graduation exercises will be determined

by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee.
