ISH offers two different strands to its sports program, Competitive and skills development through various different sports such as Soccer, volleyball, basketball, tennis, swimming, track & field and Golf.

Sports are offered on a three season basis throughout the school year with practices one- two times a week and typically 90 minutes in length. Competitions take place on weekends as well as friendly games. Teams travel throughout the season to various locations primarily within Europe.

- Become thoroughly familiar with the rules and regulations pertaining to the sport coached.
- Communicate and inform parents regarding training session details
