3) Superintendent Report

Superintendent Josh Hurt

- Last year, as part of new superintendent training, Mr. Hurt had to do a leadership assessment. He was offered to do it again this year. He said since it was a great learning tool, he opted to do it again. The results are in and will be given to board members if requested. He said it's good to see the positive things going on and the things taking place that need to be addressed.
- Virgel Hammonds from KnowledgeWorks visited the district today. Through a Kentucky Innovative Learning Network grant from KDE, he is working with our district to further implement competency-based personalized learning. He met with 12 people, including teachers, principals, directors of instruction, and community members. Today, we looked at the culture of our district. What we are doing well and what needs improvement.
- Donna Caffee, our chief financial analyst, has announced her retirement. Her replacement is Cheyenne Perry.
- Rachel Dial has been named a new director of instruction, replacing Jamie Howard, who already announced her retirement.
