


How do you feel about the Building Design?



How well do you think the new Minnie Howard building complements the King Street Campus?




How well do you think the new Minnie Howard building complements a desire for a balance between traditional and contemporary design aesthetics?








12 25-yard swimming lanes


Two 1-meter springboard diving boards

A safe, inviting, warm and shallow universally accessible pool for users not comfortable with deeper water and those programs that require shallow water




