Grade 1 - 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Informal discussion with Applicant to assess proficiency in English, communication and language skills, as well as personal and social development - Test to measure basic numeracy and literacy skills - Writing sample - Review of previous academic reports, any other school reports, and medical history - Parent consultation to learn history of Applicant, any special needs, parent expectations, and ways in which parents can participate in school life
Grade 3 - 12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Informal discussion with Applicant to assess proficiency in English, communication and language skills, personal and social development, confidence levels, ability to cooperate with others, concentration levels and behavior - Test to measure numeracy and literacy skills - Writing sample/essay - Review of previous academic reports, any other school reports, and medical history - Parent consultation to learn history of Applicant, any special talents or needs, parent expectations, and ways in which parents can participate in school life
