From football to gymnastic, we had lots of sporting successes to celebrate this week in Monet class.

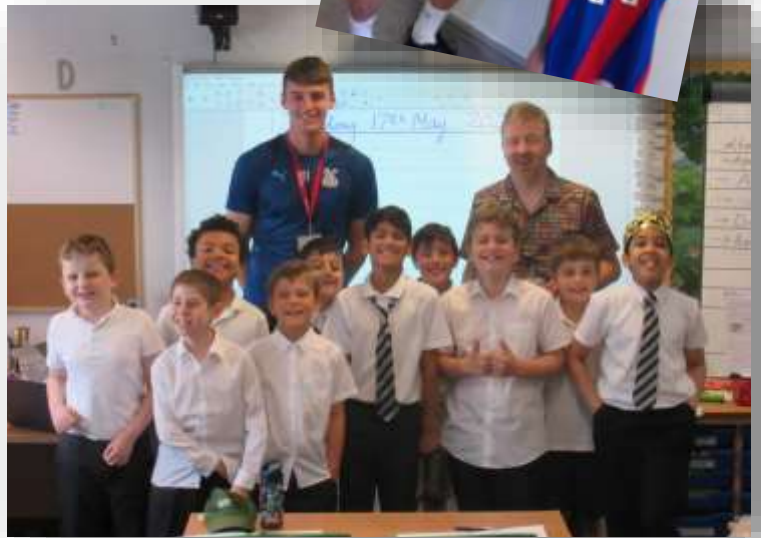
Noah and George were awarded with a medal for football and Daria picked up silver award for her amazing gymnastics prowess!
