Gatekeeper Training for Suicide Prevention

Just as people trained in CPR and the Heimlich Maneuver help save thousands of lives each year, people trained in QPR learn how to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis and how to question, persuade and refer someone to help. Each year, thousands of Americans like you are saying "Yes" to saving the life of a friend, colleague, sibling or neighbor.

As a QPR-trained Gatekeeper you will learn to:

- Recognize warning signs of suicide
- Know how to offer hope
- Know how to get help and save a life

Audience: Anyone in a position to recognize a crisis and the warning signs that someone may be contemplating suicide: parents, friends, neighbors, school staff – teachers, nurses, office personnel, counselors, psychologists, and social workers.
