- Designs efficient program components and functions using general industry best practices.
- Collaborates with supervisors and team members to arrive at solutions to programming and systems design issues.
- Conducts limited configuration analysis and design of existing systems and/or third-party vendor software.
- Assists in the documentation of applications, including errors and testing.
- Participates in research and development team activities.
- Uses modern search tools and support resources to discover or validate techniques.
- Modifies existing programs.

• Performs other related duties as assigned for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective functioning of the work unit.
