TRANSPORTATION

Welcomes you!

- Be at the bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled bus stop time (waiting at the bus stop)
- Do not approach any bus in motion
- Any transportation change in a child's regularly assigned bus pick-up/drop-off location must come through the school's office where a one-day bus pass will be issued to the student. If your child does not have this Transportation Pass, the bus driver will not permit the child on the bus
- Keep the bus garage updated with your child's address, phone number, and/or emergency contact changes during the school year
- In compliance with state law, Preschool students who are less than 40 inches tall or weigh less than 40 pounds will be placed in a safety vest by the bus monitor
- When transporting Preschool students from school, the driver will only release the child to a parent, guardian, or other authorized adult at the bus door; if no authorized adult is at the bus door, the driver will return your child to their school
- When transporting Kindergarten students from school, the driver must make eye contact with a parent, guardian, or someone authorized to receive the child; if no eye contact is made, the driver will return your child to their school
- If you wish for your Kindergarten child to get off the bus in the afternoon with an older sibling (without adult eye contact), your request must be submitted in writing, given to your child's bus driver, and approved by the Director of Transportation. Several factors are considered when making this determination. The request may or may not be approved.
- For grades 1-12, please have a plan in place in the event there is not a parent/guardian at home when your child is dropped off in the afternoon

The privilege of riding a school bus will depend upon students obeying the following rules (abbreviated):

- *School rules apply on the bus.*
- *Stay in your seat.*
- *Keep head, hands, feet inside the bus.*
- *Be courteous and respectful.*
- *Do not use inappropriate language.*
- *Keep the bus clean.*
- *Do not eat or drink (other than water) on the bus.*
- *Tobacco and vape products are never allowed.*
- *Use of cell phones are limited to music and appropriate content, must have ear buds and utilize only one of them.*
- *Do not sell anything on the bus.*
- *Cooperate with the driver.*



***Note - The bus driver and/or monitor are authorized to assign seats.**
