<u>Preschool Students attending a Private School</u>	Preschool students who are placed by their parents in a private/home school do not qualify for service plans. If a student meets eligibility criteria for speech services, that student must be enrolled in the public school by their parent in order to receive services under an IEP. Services shall be offered within the school day for 30 minutes per week.
<u>“Universal” Fours</u>	Students who are four by August 1 of the current school year, but do not meet the requirements for disability or at-risk may attend preschool at no cost on a space available basis. These students may be transported to the program by the school district.
