

How can I help my child with

MATH

Practice naming coins and learning their value. Add amounts of coins. Practice making change.

Count the dots on dominos and add them.

Count anything and everything. Practice counting to 100. Skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s.

Ask your child to find different shapes while shopping.

Ask your child to sort items by shape, size, color. Ask them to arrange items from largest to smallest.

Practice adding and subtracting using playing cards. Play war to determine which values are larger or smaller.

Play "I Spy" while driving looking for shapes and numbers in real life.

Give them word problems to solve while you are waiting in line or at the doctor.

Practice using a ruler to measure objects.

Have your child practice writing their numbers. Fun ideas include drawing in sand, sidewalk chalk, and painting.

Talk about time. Talk about how many minutes until an event or between events.
