Math

All math classes, with the exception of Algebra ABC courses, will require: either a 3-ring one inch binder or folder, ruler, and pencils. Some may require color pencils and highlighters.

Upper level Math courses- AP Calculus, AP Statistics, IB Math, Pre Calc and Algebra 2 will require (in addition to above): graph paper, notebook paper

The use of a TI 84 Plus graphing calculator. We highly encourage families to purchase their own calculator, but we do have calculators available for loan. Let your child's math teacher know if you need to borrow a

calculator. Your child will need this calculator for the first week of school, as it will be used and needed for homework/classwork.

The TI 84 Plus graphing calculator models vary: These calculators can be purchased at stores such as Walmart, Target, Staples, or on-line at Amazon.com. We suggest that you purchase these in early August to be able to take advantage of the back-to-school sales. However, be aware that several stores sell out as the first day of school approaches.

Please **do not** purchase TI 83 models. They are outdated.
