

How To Build Your Own Locker Shelf!

For better organization, it is suggested that you build your own locker shelf.

This shelf allows everything to be vertical and easy to access. It is very easy...Here's how:

1. Cut shelf pieces out of a 1" x 12" x 8" wooden board (from Lowes or Home Depot).
2. Follow the pattern below.
3. The maximum height of the shelf unit is 24". This allows for room at the top of the locker for a PE bag, lunch, or other stuff. There are also hooks in this top part of the locker. The maximum depth of the locker is 13.5". The maximum width of the locker is 14.5".
4. DO NOT assemble shelving before you put it in your locker. The only nails/screws you will need to attach will be for the two braces for the lower shelf to sit upon. No other nails or screws are necessary.
5. Paint and/or Decorate your shelves if you want!
6. Other ideas for lockers: Use magnets! Bring a magnetic mirror. Have a hanging utensil bag. Some folks like a small "touch" light in their locker. No tape is allowed in the new lockers this year!
7. Hooks are available near all lockers for backpacks and jackets. Make sure you unpack your backpack and put all books in your locker when you arrive in the mornings.
