Tuition Agreement & Payment Timeline

- **March** - Our Board of Directors will meet in March annually to set tuition for the coming school year. They are judicious in considering any increase year to year, they are also particularly sensitive to economic pressures as well as your tuition investment. The average increase is 2-3.5% annually.
- **April** – If enrolled on/before the month of April, a personalized tuition agreement and invoice will be sent to each student via mail, and payments (for all payment plans) begin in June. Your tuition agreement is personalized, and your invoice will reflect your enrollment deposit paid as well as financial aid that may apply.
- **May** - Your tuition agreement paperwork will allow you to select one of three payment options. You must return your payment option selection and signed agreement in May.
- **June** – Your first tuition payment is due.

Payment Options

- Tuition includes textbooks, activity participation fees, and all sports (except an ice hockey rink fee).

Other Costs to Consider: Uniform, Device, Supplies, Transportation

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- **Uniform** - Items can be purchased from our bookstore or Blake's Uniform Store, and some items can be purchased from other retailers. Uniform swap items will be available this summer free of charge.
- **Device** - Plan ahead to purchase an iPad, ChromeBook, laptop, or other device if you do not already own one. St Joes does not sell or rent devices. Your student's device is their property and responsibility.
- **Supplies** - St Joes does not prepare a school supply list. We suggest that your student continue to use the note-taking and organizational system that is currently working for them (binders/notebooks, etc).
- **Lunch** - Some students choose to bring a lunch, some choose to purchase lunch at school. We are catered by Catamount Catering (a part of the Vazzy's Restaurant group) and fresh options are prepared on site daily. Lunch items range from \$5-\$10. Students can purchase lunch with cash or with their student ID after setting up a "My Kids Spending" debit account (instructions available in August).
- **Bus Transportation (optional)** - There is a \$600/semester bus fee for non-Trumbull residents.

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
