

# IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS



All students entering grade 7 are required by Ohio school law to show proof of the following immunizations **BEFORE** starting school:

- **TDaP** vaccine (to protect from Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis)
- **Meningococcal (A, C, Y, W-135)** vaccine (to protect from Meningitis)  
- **Menveo, Menactra OR MenQuadfi**

***Any 7th grade student who has not had TDaP and Meningitis (A, C, Y, W-135) vaccinations will not be permitted to attend school until proof of these immunizations has been received by the school.***

Both the required TDaP and Meningitis (A, C, Y, W-135) shots can be obtained at any time from now until the first day of 7th grade. We encourage you to contact your Primary Care Physician or your local Health Department for an appointment. Don't wait, clinics tend to become very busy toward the end of summer.
