

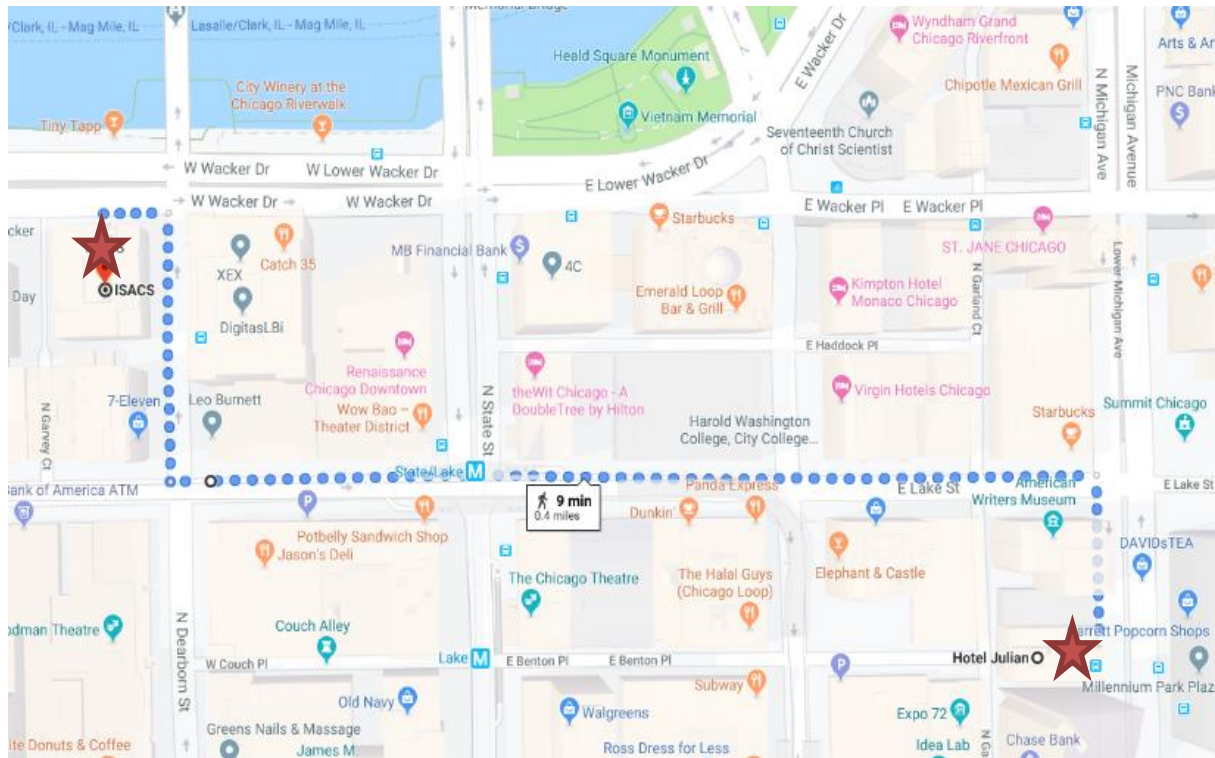

Driving Directions

These are for directional purposes only; you do not need to rent a car if you are flying to Chicago.

From Midway Airport:

- Get on I-55 N/Stevenson Expy from S Cicero Ave (2.7 mi)
- Continue to US-41 N/S Lake Shore Dr.
- Take the U.S. 41 N/Lake Shore Drive N exit from I-55 N/Stevenson Expy (7.2 mi)
- Continue on S Lake Shore Dr. Take S Columbus Dr to N Michigan Ave

From O'Hare Airport:

- Get on I-90 E from IL-171 N/N Cumberland Ave (0.8 mi)
- Follow I-90 E. Take exit 50B from I-90 E (12.8 mi)
- Continue on W Ohio St. Drive to N Michigan Ave

Parking at the Hotel Julian

Valet parking and drop off is available at the hotel west entrance at 171 North Garland Court. Please use this address when mapping directions to the hotel. Note that there is nowhere to pull up at the hotel's Michigan Ave entrance.

Valet Hourly Parking:

- 8-24 Hours: \$77/vehicle

Public Transportation

Hotel Julian is convenient to public transportation. The hotel is only 3-5 blocks from the Red, Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, and Purple line trains.

From Midway Airport: (45 minutes)

- Follow the signs for the Trains to the City. Take the CTA Orange Line towards the Loop and get off at the State and Lake stop, exit station and walk a short distance east to Michigan Ave and then turn right and walk south on Michigan Avenue. Hotel Julian will be on your right about 1 block. Cost \$3.00 each way.

From O'Hare Airport: (45 minutes to 1 hour)

- Follow the signs for the Trains to the City. Take the CTA Blue Line towards Forest Park and get off at the Clark and Lake stop, exit station and walk a short distance east to Michigan Ave and then turn right and walk south on Michigan Avenue. Hotel Julian will be on your right about 1 block. Cost of a single-ride ticket \$5.00 from O'Hare to downtown and \$3.00 from downtown to O'Hare.

If you intend to ride the CTA frequently while in Chicago, you may wish to purchase a 1-Day pass for \$10.00. If you visit Chicago often, you may wish to purchase a reloadable Ventra card for \$5.00 and the cost of the card can be applied to transit fees. Single ride will be \$2.50, but \$5.00 from O'Hare.

Prepaid Discounted Parking Option

Your parking space is guaranteed, and you will also receive directions to your parking location. You may be able to find reduced parking rates, subject to availability, by using ParkWhiz or Spot Hero for daily and/or overnight parking in downtown Chicago.
