PRE-KINDERGARTEN

- 4 boxes of 24 count crayons
- 2 3 oz or 4 oz containers of playdoh
- 4 Glue sticks
- 1 pair of blunt nose scissors
- 1 pencil box (no pouches)
- 1 clipboard – letter size

Some of the supplies may need to be replenished throughout the year.

Students should have a backpack (standard size to fit folder & lunchbox) and a lunchbox or brown bag for snack. Send in a change of clothes in a gallon size baggie (1 pair of pants, 1 short sleeved shirt, 1 underwear, & pair of socks) to keep on hand for emergencies.

- Headphones (for at school use, no ear buds, please)
- 2 12 count boxes of #2 pencils (prefer Ticonderoga brand)
- 3 Heavy Duty **Paper** Folders with pockets and brads (1 red, 1 blue, 1 yellow)

- 3 composition books (1 blue & 2 black covers)
- 2 boxes of crayons (24 count only)
- 6 glue sticks
- 8 Thin black dry erase markers
- Ear Buds or Headphones
- 3 plastic pocket folders with prongs (1 yellow, 1 red, 1 any color)
