



PCDS Summer Programs COVID-19 Sick and Reporting Policy

In the event of illness, email the Health Center (healthcenter@pcds.org) with name, date of onset of symptom(s), and contact number.

The following protocols will apply when a student or staff member shows symptoms of illness. Individuals will return home if they have a temperature of 100.4°F or higher.

Individual who tests positive for COVID-19:

- Individuals who test positive will need to remain off campus for 5 days. **They may return to campus without a negative COVID-19 test on day 6 if they are asymptomatic.** The individual must stop by the Health Center before going to class on the morning of their return to school, and CDC recommends the individual wear a mask through day 10.

Symptomatic individual who has not been tested:

- If you choose not to get tested, remain off campus for 5 days from symptom onset AND only return 24 hours after symptom resolution.

Symptomatic individual who tests negative:

- Remain off campus until 24 hours after fever resolution (if present) AND symptom resolution.

Asymptomatic individual exposed (close contact) to COVID-positive individual:

- If close contact with a COVID-positive individual occurs within the household, it is important that the Health Center be notified. The individual will need to be tested in the Health Center on days 1 through 5 before attending school. They must wear a mask for 10 days from the point of exposure. The testing & masking policy for household close contacts does not apply if the exposed individual has had COVID in the past 90 days. If the exposed individual becomes symptomatic, remain home and contact the Health Center for additional guidance.
