

VENDING MACHINES

Vending machines dispensing nutritious food and/or beverages to students are permitted in secondary schools at the discretion of the principal and require approval from the Director of Procurement and the Director of School Nutrition Services. Any vending program will include financial management and product selection coordinated by the principal and approved by the Director of Procurement and Director of School Nutrition Services. . All student vending machines will adhere to the Smart Snack or other applicable Federal guidelines.

Vending machines may not be used by students during regular school hours and are to be coordinated by the principal and approved by the Director of School Nutrition Services. This process must adhere to the ACPS Student Wellness Policy and Guidelines.

Vending machines are authorized in the teachers' lounges subject to the approval and management direction of the principal and Director of School Nutrition Services. These machines shall be for employee use only.
