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4 Duties of Teachers and Administrative Staff

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6 Any person licensed as administrative or instructional personnel by the Virginia Board of Education and employed by the Alexandria City School Board who, in the scope of his/her 7 employment, has reason to believe, as a result of direct communication from a student, that 8 such student is at imminent risk of suicide, shall, as soon as practicable, contact at least one of 9 such student's parents to ask whether such parent is aware of the student's mental state and 10 whether the parent wishes to obtain or has already obtained counseling for such student. Non-11 licensed school personnel shall immediately contact their supervisor/administrator to facilitate 12 communication with parents. All contact shall be made in accordance with the provisions of 13 the guidelines and regulations established by the Superintendent. 14

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16 Contacting the Parent/Guardian

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18 If the section below titled "Abuse or Neglect" does not apply, then the staff member shall call
19 at least one of the student's parents/guardians. When contacting a parent/guardian, the staff

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44	If the student has indicated that the reason for being at imminent risk of suicide relates to			

44 If the student has indicated that the reason for being at imminent risk of suicide relates to 45 parental abuse or neglect, contact shall not be made with the parent. Instead, the staff member

shall, as soon as practicable, notify the local department of social services of the county or city

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47 wherein the child resides or wherein the abuse or neglect is believed to have occurred or the 48 state Department of Social Services' toll-free child abuse and neglect hotline as required by 49 Policy JHG/GAE Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting and Va. Code § 63.2-1509. When 50 giving this notice to the local or state department, the person shall stress the need to take 51 immediate action to protect the child from harm.

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53 Inability to Reach Parent/Guardian

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55 If the staff member is unable to make contact with the parent/guardian by the end of the 56 school day, then he/she shall follow the ACPS Suicide Prevention/Intervention Guidelines.

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58 **Required Documentation**

The staff member shall document the phone call to the parent/guardian by recording: (a) the time and date of the call; (b) the individual contacted; (c) the parent/guardian's response; and (d) anticipated follow-up. This information shall be recorded on the forms provided in the ACPS Suicide Prevention/Intervention Guidelines.

- 64 65 **Training**
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67 School Support Team Members and School Administrators shall be trained annually to 68 become familiar with the policy and ACPS Suicide Prevention/Intervention Guidelines. In 69 addition, school administrators will ensure that all staff receive an annual review of the ACPS 70 Suicide Prevention/Intervention Guidelines for handling situations involving concerns of 71 suicide risk. The ACPS Suicide Prevention/Intervention Guidelines will be available to all 72 staff electronically and in hard copies in the health office and with the school administrator.

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74 Additional Concerns

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If parental/guardian contact is made and, in the course of this contact, relevant issues of abuse or neglect are discovered (e.g., a parent acknowledges the child's suicidal intent but indicates no intent to act for the well-being of the child), the staff member shall report the abuse or neglect in accordance with Policy JHG /GAE Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting.

- 8081 Duty to Keep Student Safe and Secure
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A student who is at imminent risk of suicide shall remain under adult supervision until a
parent/guardian or other authorized individual accepts responsibility for the student's safety.
