

INTERNET PRIVACY

The Alexandria City School Board is committed to complying with the [Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act](#) and the [Virginia Freedom of Information Act](#). Alexandria City Public Schools shall not collect unnecessary personal information by means of its website, and shall collect only appropriate personal information to the extent necessary to serve its constituents and the community.

Personal information collected and retained by the school division's website will be maintained in compliance with the [Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act](#) (Va. Code § 2.2-3800 *et seq.*). Any individual wishing to learn the purpose for which information has been recorded and the particulars of its use and dissemination may contact the Superintendent or designee regarding this information. Any person wishing to correct, erase, or amend inaccurate, obsolete, or irrelevant information may do so by procedures established by the Superintendent or designee.

The school division shall inform the public of any personal information collected through its website by posting the following privacy statement or a link to this privacy statement in a conspicuous fashion at the top of the website home page:

It is the policy of the Alexandria City Public Schools that personal information about citizens will be collected only to the extent necessary to provide the service or benefit desired; that only appropriate information will be collected; that the citizen shall understand the reason the information is collected and be able to examine his or her personal record that is maintained by a public body.

This website:

1. Collects no personal information from you, unless you specifically enter information into an online form. Internet servers do collect communication protocol addresses from the personal computers accessing the website in order to facilitate communication. By itself, this information does not constitute personal information.
2. Will not track your movements through the website.
