

12 CP English Literature Summer Reading

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The twelfth grade curriculum features a study of British Literature. Over the summer, you will read one classic and one non-fiction text. I always suggest utilizing a paper copy, but in case you do not have access to a paper copy, I have included digital links to the books.

Read the following by the first day of school:

1. Fiction text: *The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde* by Robert Louis Stevenson

2. For the non-fiction text, read ONE of the following:

- *Tuesdays with Morrie* by Mitch Albom
This book follows Mitch Albom as he visits his professor who is fighting Lou Gehrig's disease.
