The twelfth grade curriculum features a study of British Literature. Over the summer, you will read one classic and one non-fiction text.

Read the following by the first day of school:

1. *Frankenstein* by Mary Shelley
 - I suggest a paper copy, but here is a digital copy in case you do not have access to the book. <https://www.gutenberg.org/files/84/84-h/84-h.htm>
 - A test on the novel will be administered upon your return to school
2. *Callings: The Purpose and Passion of Work* by Dave Isay
 - Read the book before completing the related project
 - Complete the following project before the first day of school

Callings Project:

1. Select a person whom you would like to interview. The person may not be a family member or a BC teacher.
2. Ask the provided questions and any other questions you feel would be significant.
3. Record the responses
 - Be careful to accurately record the person's responses either by writing or audio/video recording as you interview.
 - Ask follow-up questions that encourage the interviewee to offer specifics.
 - Ask for a signature allowing for publication of the interview.
 - You will be turning in your interview sheet.
4. Compose the person's responses into a brief story about the person's vocation similar to those stories contained in *Callings*. Follow the format of the stories in *Callings*.
 - Type your story in a google doc.
 - Length should be between 1.5 and 2 pages.
 - Title should mirror the book titles: name of person and occupation "talks to" your name and relationship to the interviewee.
 - Story should also mirror the format of the stories in *Callings*.

You will need to devote ample time to completing these reading assignments over the summer. Do not procrastinate.
