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Accreditation

AISL is fully accredited by the Council of International Schools and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. The International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) has authorized AISL to offer the IB Diploma Programme. Additionally, AISL has an ongoing cyclical review of curricular needs and academic programs.

The 186 days in the school year are divided into two semesters, the first from August to December and the second from January to June.

Secondary Program

The secondary program consists of the middle school (Grades 6-8) and high school (Grades 9-12). The curriculum is rigorous, and designed to prepare AISL students for the university, college, or career path of their choice. Students are challenged to enroll in the most rigorous course work of which they are capable and for which they are prepared. AISL students have an opportunity to earn the American High School Diploma and the globally recognized IB Diploma. Students choose the coursework that best fits their goals and educational aspirations.

AISL high school students have the following co-curricular options: Associated Student Body, National Honor Society, Citizens of the World, Stop the Bull, Protect a Child, Model United Nations, Global Issues Network, Eagle Press, photography club, theatre, cooking club, competitive sports (swimming, soccer, volleyball, basketball), and after school activities (chess, karate, fencing, boxing), in addition to IB CAS and Service Learning projects.



Covid-19 Statement:

As a result of COVID19, spring 2020 semester grades all became Pass/Incomplete as our school community moved entirely online and was for the most part obligated to relocate outside of Nigeria from March 2020 until the end of the school year in June 2020. Students engaged in hybrid learning (online and in-person) during the 2020-21 school year. The 2021-2022 school year resumed with face-to-face learning and with no external incidents affecting school.

AISL uses a standards-based approach to assessment and reporting. Students are assessed on their proficiency in regards to identified education standards (Common Core State Standards, The Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS), American Education Reaches Out (AERO), and the The International Baccalaureate® (IB) Diploma Programme (DP).

AISL's 7-Point Grade Scale

7 Excellent	A mark of distinction reserved for students who consistently produce outstanding work showing a thorough understanding of the required knowledge and skills with the ability to apply them in a variety of situations. Work is always of a high quality and often original and insightful.
6 Very Good	A highly commendable level of achievement showing a consistent and thorough understanding of the required knowledge and skills. There is consistent evidence of analysis, synthesis, and evaluation. Some originality and insights may be seen.
5 Good	A good level of achievement showing consistent and thorough understanding of the required knowledge and skills. There is some evidence of analysis, synthesis and evaluation. Occasional originality and insights may be seen.
4 Satisfactory	A satisfactory level of achievement with a general understanding of the required knowledge and skills often showing their application in familiar situations. Occasional evidence of analysis, synthesis and evaluation is seen.
3 Unsatisfactory	Is a passing grade but there is room for improvement as evidence suggests limited achievement of the basic knowledge and skills or the ability to apply them in familiar situations.
2 Poor	Represents a very limited level of achievement. It is a failing grade. The student has difficulty in understanding the required knowledge and skills and is unable to apply them consistently even when supported.

International Baccalaureate

Our IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) enhances the quality of a student's educational experience by offering a comprehensive and integrated course of study during the last two years of high school. Students choose to study three subjects at the "higher level" (HL) and three "standard level" (SL) subjects. In addition, full diploma candidates are required to complete a course of study entitled Theory of Knowledge, along with a 4000-word extended essay. A further requirement is that students actively reflect upon their extracurricular activities and service projects through Creativity, activity, service (CAS).

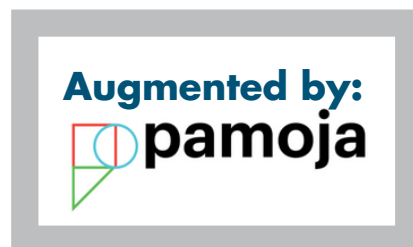

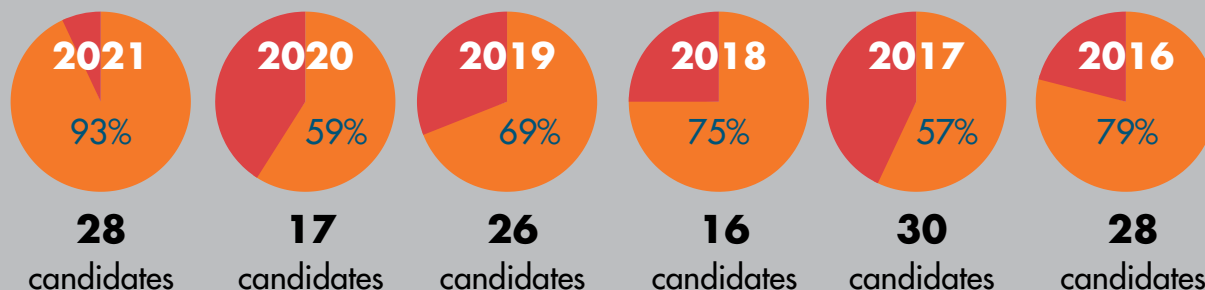


IB Overview 2021-2022

- At the moment, the trajectory is towards face to face examinations in May.
- The subject amendments for the May 2021 cohort though remain in place as a means of addressing the loss of face to face instructional time.
- These amendments only apply to the May 2022 cohort and not the cohort of May 2023 .
