AUTHORIZE INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
WITH WASHINGTON NETWORK FOR INNOVATIVE CAREERS SKILLS CENTER

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, provides for interlocal cooperation between governmental agencies, and;

WHEREAS, Washington Network for Innovative Careers (WaNIC Skills Center) herein referred to as "Skills Center" agrees to permit students of the District to attend educational programs offered at the Skills Center that are not available at the District;


WHEREAS, the District wishes to use the educational programs at the Skills Center to support the educational requirements and goals of the District;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Edmonds School District #15, Snohomish County, as follows:

1. That an interlocal cooperation agreement be formed between the Edmonds School District #15 and the WaNIC Skills Center for the purpose of permitting students to attend their educational programs from September 1, 2013 to August 31, 2018.
2. That the Superintendent or designee of Edmonds School District No.15, Snohomish County, Washington, is hereby designated as representative to the interlocal cooperation agreement, and the Superintendent or designee is further authorized to execute and implement the requisite agreement or agreements to accomplish this purpose.

Interdistrict Agreement for Cooperative Educational Services

9/1/2013 – 8/31/2018

WaNIC Skills Center is a cooperative of the Bellevue, Issaquah, Lake Washington, Mercer Island, Northshore, Riverview and Snoqualmie Valley school districts and is governed by an Administrative Council whose membership includes the superintendents from the cooperating districts. The Administrative Council has authorized the Skills Center administration to enroll students from school districts that are not part of the Skills Center cooperative on a space-available basis.

WaNIC Skills Center, herein referred to as "Skills Center" and the Edmonds School District, herein referred to as "Sending District", hereby agree to the following:

1. The purpose of this Agreement is to utilize interdistrict cooperation, authorized by RCW 28A.225.250, and WAC 392-135, to provide educational programs not otherwise available and to avoid duplications of specialized programs and facilities. These objectives will be achieved by enrollment and attendance in programs at the WaNIC Skills Center.
2. Student enrollment hours are defined to mean the hours that each student is enrolled and carried on the enrollment register without regard to the actual attendance of the student. The Sending District shall be entitled to retain all apportionment received by them from Federal and State sources for its own students while in attendance in its schools. When a student attends the Skills Center, however, the Skills Center's host district, Lake Washington, shall claim State and Federal support for students while in attendance in a Skills Center program.
3. The Lake Washington School District shall report enrollment and claim apportionment for Sending District students in the same manner as for students who attend from the cooperating districts. In accordance with WAC 392-121-136, students enrolled at the Skills Center and at a high school are reported for a maximum combined 1.6 FTE. A student's resident high school FTE cannot exceed 1.00 and the student's skills center FTE cannot exceed 1.00.
4. It will be the responsibility of the sending school district to adjust their enrollment reporting accordingly. The Sending District will be notified of any enrollment changed by WaNIC.
5. The Sending District shall be responsible for providing special education, section 504, and ancillary services for their student, retaining the student within their district, ensuring the student is following the Sending District's guidelines for graduation.
6. The WaNIC shared student agreement shall be completed for each participating student.

This agreement shall remain in effect as long as the Sending District continues to send students to the Skills Center or until such time as the Skills Center Administrative Council may change its policy or deem that the Skills Center is operating at full capacity for the students within the cooperative. The agreement may be modified by mutual consent of both the Skills Center and the Sending District. Either party may revoke the agreement at the end of an academic year, provided however, that notice of such revocation shall be delivered to the other party no less than (90) days prior to the end of the academic year. The 90-day minimum notice requirement may be waived by mutual consent of both parties.

This agreement shall remain in effect for 9/1/2013 to 8/31/2018.

Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the Washington Network for Innovative Careers Skill Center (WaNIC) and the Edmonds School District. Resolution No. 13-18.

Per approval of this agreement, approved Edmonds School District students will be permitted to enroll in the WaNIC Skill Center to utilize approved preparatory vocational training programs. This arrangement will expire on August 31, 2018, unless the agreement is terminated prior to such date in accordance with the written agreement.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the Edmonds School District and the Washington network for Innovative Careers (WaNIC) Skill Center be approved.

Background

The Edmonds School District is a member of the Sno-Isle Skill Center consortium of districts served by the Sno-Isle Skill Center located in South Snohomish County. To the greatest extent possible, the Sno-Isle Skill Center seeks to provide preparatory vocational training to Edmonds School District students through their programs as space permits. While the majority of our student seeking skill center training are served through the Sno-Isle Skill Center, there are situations in which some students cannot access training at Sno-Isle Skill Center due to limited enrollment capacity. In these situations, student unable to access Sno-Isle programs are in need of additional skill center training options.

The Washington Network for Innovative Careers (WaNIC) is a state approved skill center located in Northeast King County, which provides vocational training to students from districts within the WaNIC Skill Center consortium. Member districts within this consortium include Bellevue, Issaquah, Lake Washington, Mercer Island, Northshore, Riverview, and Snoqualmie Valley. Because of its relative proximity to the Edmonds School District, WaNIC provides a viable skill center training option for students unable to access Sno Isle Skill Center programs for the reasons cited earlier. However, because the Edmonds School District is not a member of the WaNIC Skill Center consortium, our students cannot enroll in these vocational programs without an established Interlocal Agreement.

The parties desire to enter this cooperation relationship so as to benefit each other and the student community served by ESD and WaNIC Skill Center.
