_____ **Chapter 30:** The Montgomery GI Bill ® Active Duty Educational Assistance Program known as MGIB-AD, provides education benefits to Veterans and Service Members who have at least two years active duty. Benefit typically paid to student on monthly basis.

_____ **Chapter 31:** Assists Veterans with service connected disabilities and an employment handicap to prepare for, obtain and maintain a job. Also helps entitled transition for Servicemembers.

_____ **Chapter 33:** Post 9/11 GI Bill® helps you pay for school or job training. If you served on active duty after September 10, 2001 you may qualify.

_____ **Chapter 35:** If you are a child or a spouse of a Veteran or service member who has died, is captured or missing, or has disabilities, you may be able to get help paying for school or job training through the DEA Program.
